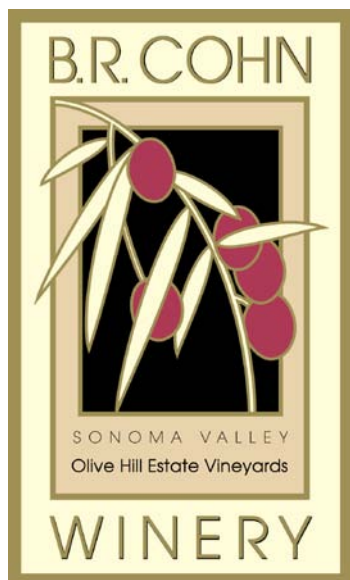

Chronicle Wine Competition, Best of Class at L.A. International Wine & Spirits Competition and Best of Class in Jerry Mead's New World International Wine Competition.

B.R. Cohn Winery has consistently produced one of the premier Cabernets in California from their Olive Hill Estate Vineyards in the heart of the Sonoma Valley. Underground natural hot springs warm the soil, and gentle ocean breezes create a unique microclimate perfectly suited for growing Cabernet Sauvignon. The long warm 2007 growing season and smaller concentrated berries yielded one of the best Cabernets to date. This wine has pronounced aromas and flavors of plum, black currant, and cherry. This vintage was aged for 24 months in only the finest tight grain French oak. A bouquet of fine oak, anise and mint combine with supple tannin and a long finish to produce a well-balanced rich full-bodied Cabernet that will age well for years to come.

B.R. Cohn Winery is located at 15000 Sonoma Highway 12 in Glen Ellen, CA. The tasting room is open daily from 10 – 5pm.
