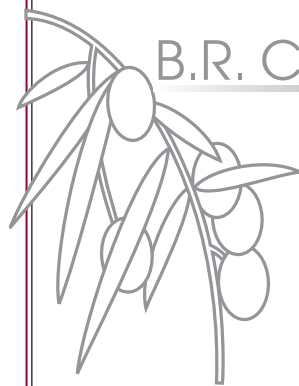
### Olive Hill Estate Vineyards

B.R. Cohn also produces Chardonnay from the Carneros region and Merlot and SyrCab from Sonoma Valley.*

*In addition to its award-winning wines, B.R. Cohn makes world-class California gourmet Olive Oils and hand-crafted Vinegars. The Estate Olive Oil is crafted from 140-year-old French Picholine olive trees imported from France in the mid 1800s, which surround the estate.*

*Since founding the winery, Bruce Cohn's focus has been to create wines that emphasize balance, elegance and consistent high quality from vintage to vintage.*
